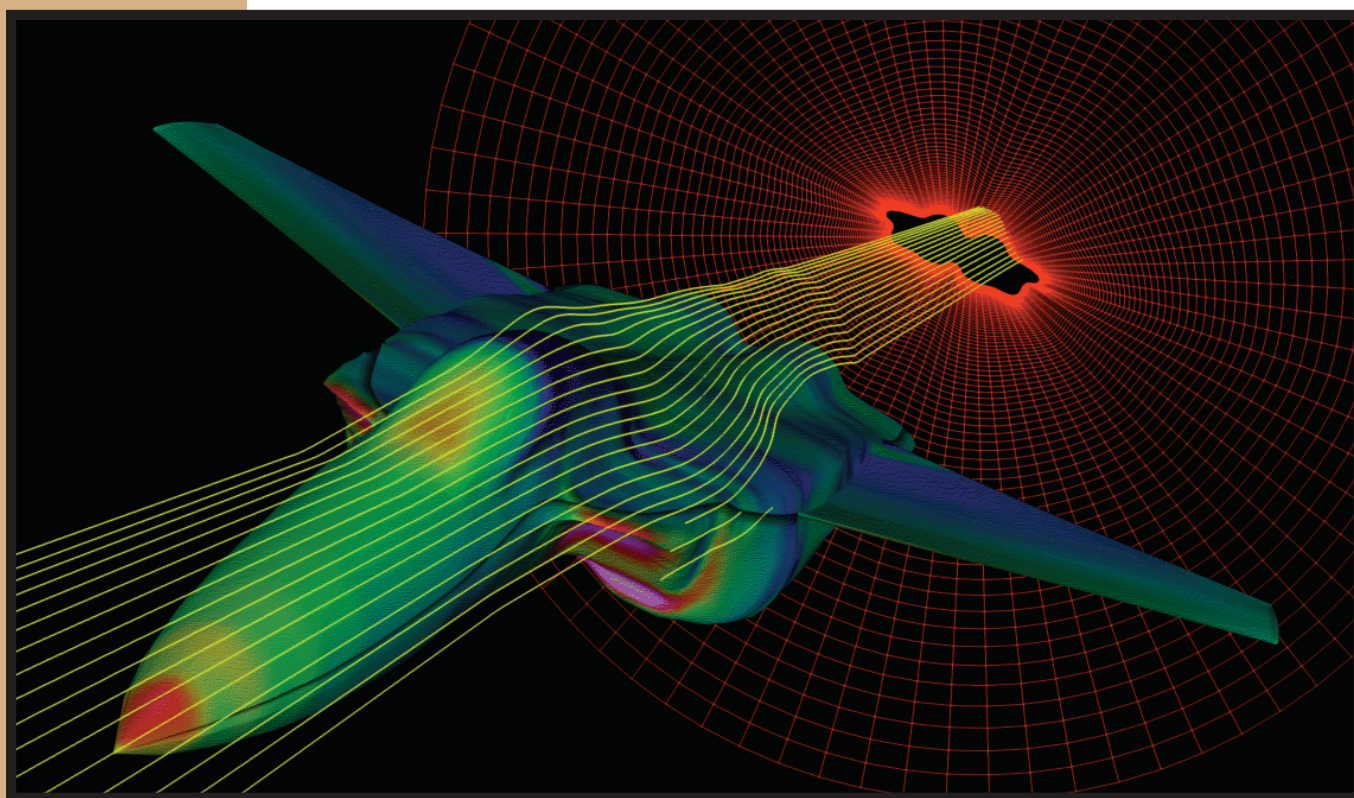




Designing Aircraft
